

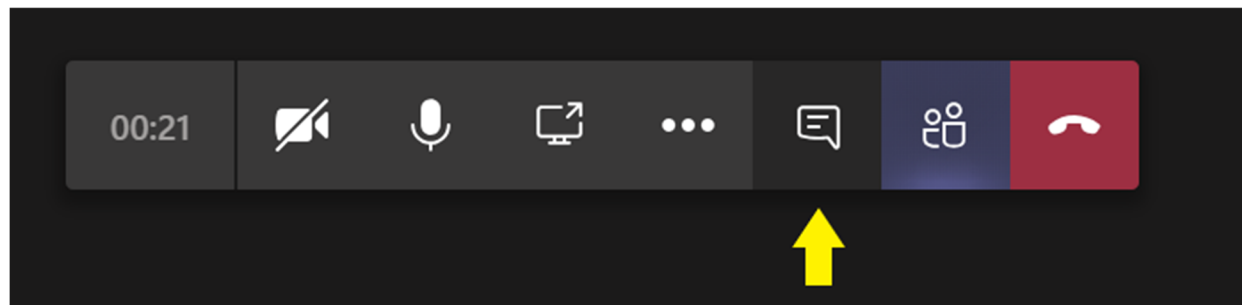

# RULEMAKING

## Types of rulemaking

- Permanent rulemaking
- Emergency rulemaking – 60 days
- Temporary rulemaking – 270 days

# RULEMAKING

## Emergency rules (**replaced or no longer in effect**)

- Assistance to for-profit barber schools with 20 or fewer students enrolled (legislation proposed)
- Assistance for schools offering online education (discussed later)
- Waiver of requirements during disaster/emergency (replaced)
- Requirements for barber school instructors during the pandemic
- Extension of renewal deadlines in 2020

# RULEMAKING

Permanent rules (**formerly temporary rules**): 21 NCAC 06N .0111 – form BAR-10. During state of emergency:

- 30 days (rather than 5 business days) to submit hours
- Return student permit within 60 days rather than 5 business days
- Increase of per-day limit of instruction hours from 8 to 10

# RULEMAKING

Permanent rules (**formerly temporary rules**): 21 NCAC 06F .0128 - waiver of requirements during disaster or emergency.

- Again, only during state of emergency
- Examples:
  - Submit reports by last day of month (rather than 15th)
  - Return student permit within 60 days rather than 5 business days
  - Increase of per-day limit of instruction hours from 8 to 10

# RULEMAKING

## State of emergency:

- Must be called by governor
- A state of emergency declared by the school wouldn't qualify
- May only apply to certain schools, depending on emergency
- Board will communicate with affected schools

# RULEMAKING

## Online classes

- Currently temporary rules
- Expire in April unless permanent rules approved by Rules Review Commission on March 18
- No legal limit of online hours – only a practical limit
- Other responsibilities must be fulfilled (e.g., time recording)



# RULEMAKING

Online classes (if approved by Rules Review Commission on March 18). 21 NCAC 06F .0120 – curriculum: online classes

- 576 hours online as specified in curriculum (board plans to revisit later)
- Through December 31, 2021, 1528 hours can be offered online

# RULEMAKING

How to ask for rules to be changed:

- Informal – contact executive director
- Formal – petition for rulemaking

# LEGISLATION

Just informational – may not affect schools:

- SB 176 – mobile barbershops
- HB 29 – verification of immigration status
- HB 88 – modify fees
- HB (number TBD) – merger with Board of Electrolysis Examiners, mobile barbershops, instructor-student ratio, and other matters

# RENEWALS

- Renew by May 31
  - Schools can renew online or by mail
  - If you renew by mail, you must include the renewal form
- **Verify that all barber instructors have renewed before you allow them to instruct**
- Noncompliance with renewal might lead to noncompliance with other statutory requirements

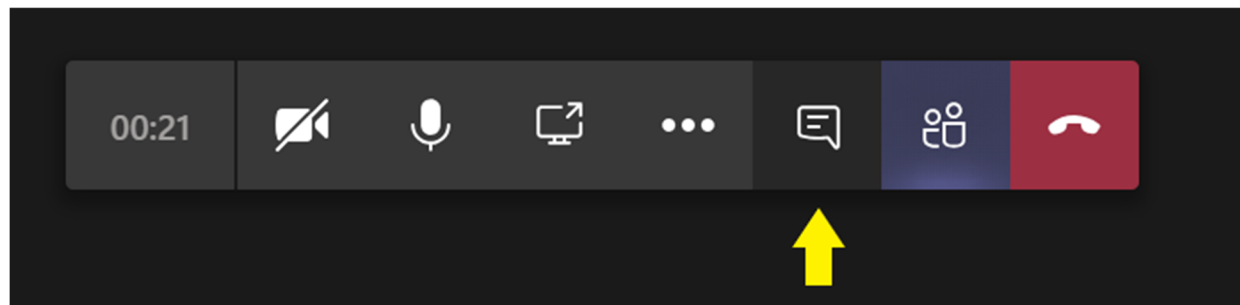

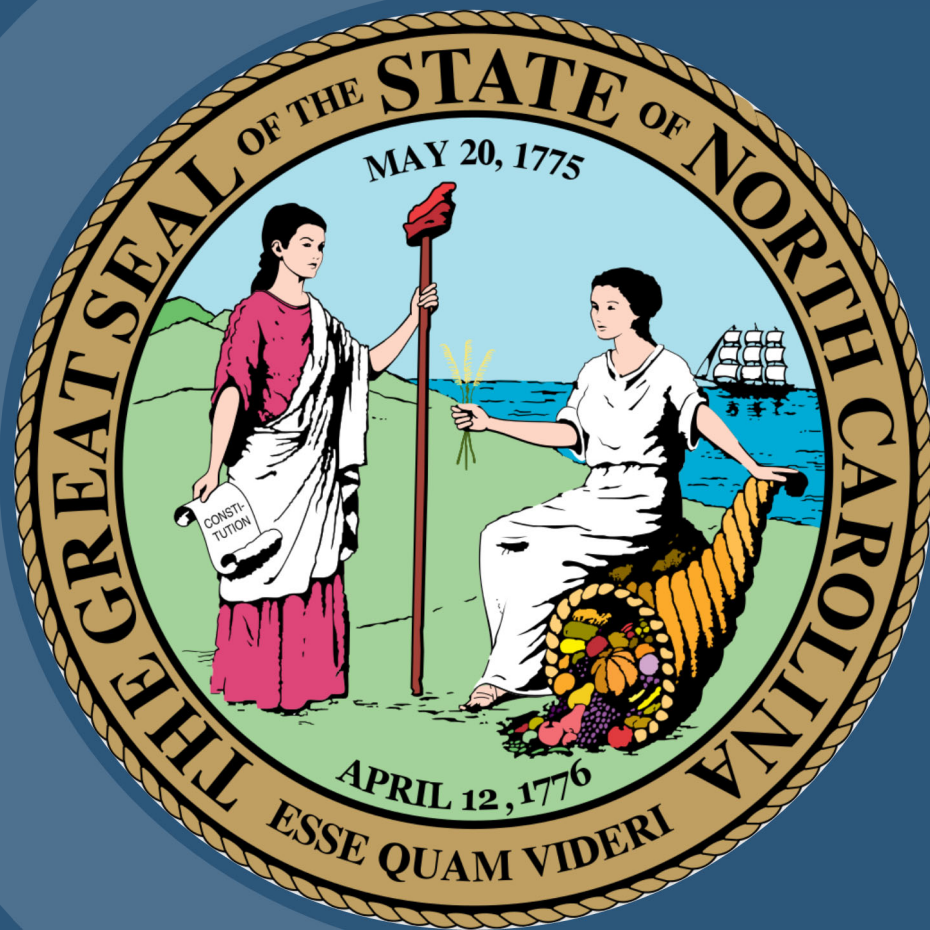
